FIRST IN CHIEF - COMMAND

Responsibilities

- Assume Command
- Continuous Size up of the situation
- Establish incident objectives
- Request resources
- Organize resources
- Provide strong command presence

Information you need

- Pre-plan
- Briefings from crews

Radio Frequency

- Establish a communication plan
 - Fire tactical
 - Logistics tactical
- Fix any communication problems!

Obtain

- Briefing from First in Captain
- Briefing from Lobby Control

Consider

- Where you want the Command Post – inside or outside
- Bumping into Ops on arrival of another Chief Officer
- Requesting PD Supervisor to the Command Post
- Requesting Facility personnel to the Command Post
- Requesting additional staff for assistance
 - Base and Stairwell
 - Operations Section Chief
 - Logistics Section Chief
 - Aids – Radio, scribe, etc...
 - Public Information Officer
 - Safety Officer

ACTIONS

- **Announce your assumption of command – Pass city coverage**
 - Obtain Briefings
- **Establish and announce your Command Post Location**
- **Connect with Facility Personnel**
- **Provide follow up report:**
 - Fire Situation
 - Request additional alarms
 - Assign First alarm crews
 - 2 - Fire Attack
 - 1 - Ventilation
 - 1 - Lobby
 - Staging
- **Establish the Incident Action Plan**
 - Evacuation **or** Protect in place
 - Fire Attack
 - Search
 - Ventilation
 - RIT
 - Logistics
- **Organize incident**
 - Announce Assignments
- **Establish Passport Accountability**
- **Announce Base Location**
- **Announce Staging Location**
- **Designate logistics tactical freq**
- **Re-Evaluate your Incident Action Plan, make adjustments**
